

CPE Credit Program - FAQ

Continuing Professional Education (CPE) certification at Adobe Experience Makers Government Forum is being administered by Government Business Results, LLC.

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Q: How do I register for the event?

A: Register for Adobe Experience Makers Government Forum via their [online registration page](#).

Q: Are all sessions at Adobe Experience Makers Forum 2021 certified?

A: Yes. There are four tracks at this year's Adobe Experience Makers Government Forum that are designated for CPE certification: Department of Defense, Federal, National Security, State & Local. These breakout tracks can be found on the event [agenda](#) page. Attendees must attend a minimum of two of the 30-minute sessions to obtain 1.2 CPE credits.

NOTE: The first two 30-minute sessions offer 1.2 CPE credits. Every additional 30-minute session attended equates to another .6 credit. To apply for CPE credit, attendees must fill out an application [HERE](#) after the completion of the event. Once your attendance and engagement are verified, a copy of your certificate(s) will be emailed to you within 10-15 business days.

Q: Can I attend one session in a track and receive .6 credit?

A: No. You must attend a minimum of two session from any of the tracks and participate in periodic check-insthroughout the sessions in order to receive CPE credits. Partial credit will not be given for attending only one session.

Q: Is there a separate registration process for the Adobe Experience Makers Government ForumCPE courses?

A: No. There is no additional registration requirement to receive CPE certification. NOTE: to receive CPE credits you must attend the selected sessions in full and actively participate in the periodic check-ins during each 30-min period.

Q: Is there a cost for obtaining CPE credits for the Adobe Digital Government Symposium?

A: There is no additional charge for CPE certification to those registered for Adobe Experience Makers Government Forum.

Q: Are there any pre-work requirements to attend a CPE certified session?

A: No. There are no prerequisites or advanced preparation required for the session.

Q: Do I need to bring anything to the session to obtain CPE credits?

A: No. There are no additional materials needed to fulfill the requirements for CPE certification.

Q: How do I receive my CPE credits?

A: After the completion of the sessions, attendees must fill out an application [HERE](#) to receive CPE credits. Once your attendance and engagement are verified, a copy of your certificate(s) will be emailed to you within 10-15 business days.

Q: Is there a deadline for requesting my CPE certificate(s)?

A: Yes. You must request your CPE certificate(s) within six months after Adobe Digital Government Symposium concludes.
